The High Chiefs Bode and Betty Osedimilehin Foundation HCBBO was born out of a deep passion to give back to society and the community, High Chief Dr. Olabode Samson Osedimilehin, the Basegun of Owo Kingdom, and his wife, High Chief Mrs. Oluwatoyin Elizabeth Osedimilehin, the Yeye Basegun of Owo Kingdom, incorporated The High Chiefs Bode and Betty Osedimilehin Foundation to bridge the gap between financial hardship and educational opportunity through scholarships for talented students from low-income families, empowering women with little or low business capitals and artisans who have financial difficulties in boosting their trades for optimal incomes in Nigeria. This foundation is opening doors to brighter futures and unlocking the potential of the people..

HCBBO Foundation's mission is simply committed to raising funds operating with honesty and transparency to support indigent public schools - primary, secondary and technical college students, whose parents are financially incapable to pay for tuitions, books, uniforms and other study materials that can assist them in the course of their studies despite their brilliance. The foundation believes that money should not be a barrier to deprive the students from acquiring needed education.



The ability of the HCBBO Foundation in engaging its entrepreneur partners across geographies in acts of giving has enabled it strengthen our youths, empower women and artisans in the community thereby volunteering time and resources to make a real impact. Too Brilliant To Be Left Behind: The Story Of A 16 Year Old Girl

Adekola Esther is just 16, a bright Senior Secondary 2 student with dreams bigger than her small world. But today, those dreams hang by a thread. She was denied the chance to sit for her promotion exam—not because she lacked brilliance, but because her grandmother could not pay her third-term school fees.

Life dealt Esther a heavy blow early. Her mother passed away when she was only four, and not long after, her father died tragically in an accident. Since then, her aging grandmother has carried the burden of raising her, with barely enough to feed them both.

To survive, Esther hawks puff-puff on the streets, balancing a tray on her head when she should be balancing equations in class. Yet behind her tired eyes lies a sharp mind and a heart determined to break free from the cycle of poverty.

Esther's story is not an isolated one—it echoes the struggles of countless children whose



brilliance is dimmed by financial hardship. And it is for students like Esther that this Foundation exists: to give hope where it seems lost, to rewrite stories of despair into stories of triumph, and to ensure that poverty never again decides a child's future.

Hcbbo Foundation's Expectations In The Near Future

At the High Chiefs Bode and Betty Osedimilehin Foundation, we see a future where no child in Ondo State is left behind because of poverty. We dream of classrooms filled with bright young minds, not held back by lack of school fees or textbooks, but propelled forward by opportunity, scholarship, and hope.

In the near future, we expect to raise a new generation of scholars—sons and daughters of farmers, traders, artisans—who will rise to become doctors, engineers, teachers, innovators, and leaders of tomorrow. We believe that education is the greatest gift, and with it, the cycle of poverty can be broken forever.

We are committed to spreading this impact across every local government in Ondo State, so

that from Owo to Ose, from Akure to Idanre, every community will boast of beneficiaries whose lives have been transformed through our support.

And beyond scholarships, we see centers of hope—libraries, digital hubs, and mentorship programs—that will sharpen the talents of our students and prepare them for the global stage.

Our expectation is simple, yet profound: that every indigent student we touch will one day stand tall to say, 'Because of HCBBO Foundation, I had a chance to dream, and I fulfilled it.'

This is the future we are building, and together, we will make it a reality.
